DIRECTIVE NO. 95

SUBJECT: Auxiliary Police Training - Firearms

Due to the many inquiries concerning the training and authority to carry firearms by Auxiliary Police, this statement of policy is hereby directed to all State, county and municipal authorities and should be related to Directive No. 30.

Although firearms training is not a mandatory requirement of Auxiliary Police, the authorization for arming of Auxiliary Police rests solely with the local governing body and subject to the approval of the Chief of Police. Should the municipality choose to authorize the Auxiliary Police to carry firearms, they must comply with the State of New Jersey Police Training Commission's requirements which are authorized in the Gun Control Act A-17:12.

Any problems arising from the use of firearms during training, competitions or assigned duties will be the sole responsibility of the municipality giving the authorization.

Directive No. 95 dated January 26, 1982 is hereby revised.
