DIRECTIVE NO. 97

SUBJECT: Residency Requirements - Auxiliary Police

1. All members of the Auxiliary Police must be residents of the municipality where they hold such membership. This order took effect on April 16, 1980.
2. Any member of an Auxiliary Police Department, who has completed Auxiliary Police training and has been a sworn member of the local Auxiliary Police Department prior to March 31, 1980, without complying with the residency requirement, may continue membership with the Department upon the approval of the local Chief of Police and local Emergency Management Coordinator where membership is presently held.
